

Secretary's Report: Calendar Year 2022

Here is a summary of the work of the Illinois Ornithological Records Committee (IORC) during 2022. Please note that that summary may not be all inclusive. Individuals are encouraged to consult the minutes of IORC meetings as well.

- The 27th report of IORC is written but is not yet published in Meadowlark. This report covers records reviewed during the 2021 calendar year.
- At the 19 March 2022 Annual Meeting, Davida Kalina was elected to a second three-year term on IORC, and Kyle Wiktor was elected as a new member.
- Lesser Goldfinch was added to the Illinois State List of Birds (and to the Review List) upon acceptance of record 2022-014.
- Brown Booby was added to the Illinois State List of Birds (and to the Review List) upon acceptance of record 2022-024.
- Painted Redstart was added to the Illinois State List of Birds (and to the Review List) upon acceptance of record 2022-048.
- In 2022, IORC made decisions on 195 circulated records. There were 175 1st circulations, 16 2nd circulations, three 3rd circulations, and one 4th circulation.
 - Of the 175 1st circulations of records, four were accepted on specimen evidence, 129 were accepted based on physical evidence, 12 were accepted based on the full collection of documentary evidence, 15 were rejected based on identification, and 15 were moved to a second circulation.
 - Of the 16 2nd circulations of records, one was accepted on physical evidence, one was accepted based on the full collection of documentary evidence, 10 were rejected based on identification, one was rejected for reasons other than identification or origin, and three were moved to a third circulation.
 - Of the three 3rd circulations of records, one was accepted based on the full collection of documentary evidence, and two were moved to a fourth circulation.
 - The one 4th circulation of a record was rejected based on identification.
- The IORC online database at <http://empty-sunset-8541.herokuapp.com/> is not presently available. Tom and Katie Kelly are working to get it restored. The content remains unchanged since the last secretary's report. Information from the first 22 IORC reports has been entered into the database. Data from the 23rd report forward have not yet been entered (these decisions are available at <https://www.illinoisbirds.org/illinois-ornithological-records-committee/>).
- The Official Illinois State List of Birds (published online at <http://www.illinoisbirds.org/the-birds-of-illinois/>) is up to date with the present AOS taxonomy (through 7th edition on the check-list and through the 63rd supplement published in August 2022).

- The IORC Web Resources and Review Files web site (<http://geoffwilliamson.info/iorc/>) is no longer password protected. All phone numbers, email addresses, residential addresses, and similar types of information have been redacted from the documents available at the site, and going forward any such information will be redacted from documents at the site.

On and after the Annual Meeting on 19 March 2022, the results of concluded circulations were as follows.

From the circulation of 22 March 2022:

- **Record 2019-078**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Anhinga during 20 August to 6 September 2019 at Grand Tower, Jackson County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of five A-PE and two A-DE(1).
- **Record 2019-079**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Barn Owl on 22 April 2019 at Montrose Point in Chicago's Lincoln Park, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-DE(1).
- **Record 2019-080**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Little Gull during 6-7 November 2019 at Lake Decatur, Macon County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2019-081**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Pacific Loon during 14-15 December 2019 at Lyerla Lake, Union County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2019-082**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 7 September 2019 at Illinois Beach State Park, Lake County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of five A-PE and two U-I.
- **Record 2019-083**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Prairie Falcon during 1 November 2019 to 1 March 2020 in northern Coles County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2019-084**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Ruff during 1-9 August 2019 at Emiquon National Wildlife Refuge, Fulton County and Chautauqua National Wildlife Refuge, Mason County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2019-085**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 11 May 2019 at Horseshoe Lake State Park, Madison County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of five A-DE(1) and two U-I.

- **Record 2020-125**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Hoary Redpoll on 10 December 2020 at Afton Forest Preserve, DeKalb County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of two A-PE and five U-I.
- **Record 2020-133**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Palm Warbler (Yellow) on 7 May 2020 at Gremel Nature Sanctuary, Lee County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one U-ID.
- **Record 2020-149**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Gyrfalcon during 13-14 November 2020 north of Charleston, Coles County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2020-150**
This was the first circulation of a breeding record of Merlin during 13 May to 2 July 2020 in Galesburg, Knox County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of three A-PE, one A-DE(2), two A-DE(1), and one A-DE(0).
- **Record 2020-151**
This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Crossbill during 20 December 2020 to 26 February 2021 north of Peoria, Woodford County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2020-152**
This was the first circulation of a record of one to three White-winged Crossbills during 26 November to 9 December 2020 at Lake Bloomington, McLean County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2021-046**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Black Rail on 30 June 2021 near Waterfall Glen Forest Preserve, DuPage County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of one A-DE(1) and six U-ID.
- **Record 2021-057**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Mottled Duck during 14-27 June 2021 at Emiquon National Wildlife Refuge, Fulton County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one U-ID.
- **Record 2021-070**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Dark-eyed Junco (Pink-sided) on 9 November 2021 in Champaign, Champaign County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of three A-PE and four U-ID.
- **Record 2021-084**
This was the second circulation of a record of one White-winged Crossbill on 1 December 2021 at Lyons Woods Forest Preserve, Lake County. The result was to move the record to a 3rd circulation, with a vote tally of four A-DE(1) and three U-I.

- **Record 2021-091**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Prairie Falcon during 2 November 2021 to 2 March 2022 southeast of Arcola in Coles and Douglas counties. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2021-092**
This was the first circulation of a record of one to two Barn Owls during 3 October to 16 December 2021 at Dixon Waterfowl Refuge, Putnam County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2021-096**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Anhinga on 8 May 2021 at McDowell Grove Forest Preserve, DuPage County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of one A-PE and six U-ID.
- **Record 2021-100**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Ruby-throated Hummingbird on 29 December 2021 in Antioch, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(1).
- **Record 2021-102**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire during 31 December 2021 to 9 January 2022 at Garden of the Gods Recreation Area, Shawnee National Forest, Saline County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2021-103**
This was the first circulation of a record of one King Eider on 23 December 2021 at Heidecke Lake, Grundy County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(1).
- **Record 2021-104**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Hoary Redpoll during 30-31 December 2021 at Northwestern University, Evanston, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2021-108**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Common Nighthawk on 24 November 2021 at East Fork Lake, Richland County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of five A-DE(1) and two U-I.
- **Record 2021-110**
This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Crossbill during 17 January to 8 February 2021 in Tolono, Champaign County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2021-114**
This was the first circulation of a record of three Barn Owls during 5-21 October 2021 at Saybrook Habitat Area, Anchor Township, McLean County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of five A-PE and two A-DE(1).

- **Record 2022-001**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Hoary Redpoll during 5-7 January 2022 in Wheaton, DuPage County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-002**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Hoary Redpoll on 6 January 2022 in Brownstown, Fayette County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one U-ID.
- **Record 2022-003**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire during 6 January to 12 March 2022 at Moraine Hills State Park, McHenry County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-004**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Great-tailed Grackle during 17 January to 20 April 2022 in Monee, Will County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-005**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Barn Owl on 8 January 2022 at Thatcher Woods Forest Preserve, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of two A-SP and five A-PE.
- **Record 2022-006**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Barrow's Goldeneye during 12-15 January 2021 at Wilmington Island Park, Will County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of four A-PE and three U-I.
- **Record 2022-008**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Hoary Redpoll on 1 February 2022 in Rockford, Winnebago County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-DE(1).
- **Record 2022-009**
This was the first circulation of a record of up to 35 White-winged Crossbills during 31 January to 20 March 2022 at Lyons Woods Forest Preserve, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-010**
This was the first circulation of a record of up to 16 White-winged Crossbills during 1-13 February 2022 at Afton Forest Preserve, DeKalb County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-011**
This was the first circulation of a record of up to 17 White-winged Crossbills during 13 February to 9 April 2022 at Shamrock Hills Park, Crystal Lake, McHenry County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2022-012**
This was the first circulation of a record of up to 35 White-winged Crossbills during 13 February to 5 March 2022 at Memorial Park Cemetery, Skokie, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-013**
This was the first circulation of a record of one to two Hoary Redpolls during 12-14 February 2022 in Lake Barrington, Lake County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of seven U-ID.

From the circulation of 6 June 2022:

- **Record 2017-088**
This was the first circulation of a record of one blue morph Ross's Goose on 6 March 2017 at Carlyle Lake, Clinton County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2018-079**
This was the first circulation of a record of one blue morph Ross's Goose on 17 March 2018 at Carlyle Lake, Clinton County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one U-ID.
- **Record 2019-082**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 7 September 2019 at Illinois Beach State Park, Lake County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of three A-PE and four U-ID.
- **Record 2019-085**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 11 May 2019 at Horseshoe Lake State Park, Madison County. The result was to move the record to a 3rd circulation, with a vote tally of five A-DE(1) and two U-ID.
- **Record 2019-086**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Black-headed Grosbeak on 2 June 2019 at Hastings Lake, Lake County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of one A-DE(1) and six U-ID.
- **Record 2019-087**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's x Black-throated Green Warbler (hybrid) on 14 May 2019 at Washington Park, Chicago, Cook County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of five A-DE(1) and two U-ID.
- **Record 2020-134**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 10 September 2020 at Park No. 566, Chicago, Cook County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of four A-DE(1) and three U-ID.
- **Record 2020-135**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 9 September 2020 at

Waukegan Beach, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of two A-DE(3) and five A-DE(1).

- **Record 2020-136**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Say's Phoebe on 11 April 2020 at Geneva, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-137**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Swallow-tailed Kite on 13 August 2020 in Butler Grove Township, Montgomery County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-138**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Swallow-tailed Kite during 29 August to 19 September 2020 east of Anna, Union County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-139**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire during 2-3 May 2020 east of Pontiac, Livingston County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-140**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire on 16 October 2020 at Saganashkee Slough, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-141**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire on 20 November 2020 at Centennial Park in Park Ridge, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(1).

- **Record 2020-142**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire on 4 December 2020 at Hampshire Forest Preserve, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-143**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Western Tanager during 8-12 May 2020 in Hoopeston, Vermilion County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-144**

This was the first circulation of a record of four White Ibis on 4 August 2020 at Big Lake, Brown County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-145**

This was the first circulation of a record of one to three White Ibis during 7-16 August 2020 at

Kaskaskia Island, Randolph County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-146**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White Ibis on 2 September 2020 at Grand Tower, Jackson County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of two A-DE(1) and five U-ID.

- **Record 2020-147**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White-faced Ibis during 29-30 September 2020 at Goose Lake Prairie State Natural Area, Grundy County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-148**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Yellow-rumped Warbler (Audubon's) on 22 May 2020 at Illinois Beach State Park, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-153**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Western Tanager during 12-17 May 2020 in Downers Grove, DuPage County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2021-084**

This was the third circulation of a record of one White-winged Crossbill on 1 December 2021 at Lyons Woods Forest Preserve, Lake County. The result was to move the record to a 4th circulation (after discussion at a meeting of IORC), with a vote tally of one A-DE, three A-DE(1), and three U-ID.

- **Record 2021-108**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Common Nighthawk on 24 November 2021 at East Fork Lake, Richland County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of six A-DE(1) and one U-ID.

- **Record 2022-006**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Barrow's Goldeneye during 12-15 January 2021 at Wilmington Island Park, Will County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of two A-DE(1) and five U-ID.

- **Record 2022-014**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Lesser Goldfinch during 5-16 March 2022 at Sagawau Environmental Learning Center, east of Lemont, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(1). This is a first state record of the species.

- **Record 2022-015**

This was the first circulation of a record one Hoary Redpoll during 6-8 March 2022 in Evanston, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2022-016**
This was the first circulation of a record of up to 15 White-winged Crossbill during 10-13 March 2022 at Binnie Forest Preserve, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-017**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Gyrfalcon on 23 March 2022 east of Monticello, Piatt County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of five A-PE and two U-ID.
- **Record 2022-018**
This was the first circulation of a record one Dark-eyed Junco (Pink-sided) during 4-5 April 2022 in Chicago, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-019**
This was the first circulation of a record one Neotropic Cormorant on 5 April 2022 at East Fork Lake, Richland County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one U-ID.
- **Record 2022-020**
This was the first circulation of a record one Snowy Plover during 23-24 April 2022 at Montrose Point in Chicago's Lincoln Park, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-021**
This was the first circulation of a record one Cassin's Vireo on 23 April 2022 at Ewing Park, Bloomington, McLean County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of one A-PE and six U-ID.
- **Record 2022-022**
This was the first circulation of a record one Ruff on 25 April 2022 northwest of Champaign, Champaign County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

From the circulation of 26 June 2022:

- **Record 2012-059**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Western Tanager on 20 May 2012 at Jackson Park, Chicago, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-DE(1).
- **Record 2017-089**
This was the first circulation of a record one Anhinga on 6 May 2017 at Mermet Lake, Massac County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of three A-DE(1) and four U-ID.
- **Record 2018-081**
This was the first circulation of a record one Brown Pelican on 5 May 2018 at Lake Pittsfield, Pike

County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2018-082**

This was the first circulation of a record one Sage Thrasher on 29 October 2018 in Kansas Township, Woodford County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2019-090**

This was the first circulation of a record one Say's Phoebe on 13 September 2019 at Chautauqua National Wildlife Refuge, Mason County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2019-091**

This was the first circulation of a record one Say's Phoebe on 18 October 2019 at Jarvis Bird Sanctuary in Chicago's Lincoln Park, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one U-XX. This record will undergo a 2nd circulation on the request of Terry Walsh and Geoffrey A. Williamson.

- **Record 2020-118**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Cinnamon Teal during 27-28 September 2022 at Carlyle Lake, Clinton County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of four A-PE and three U-ID.

- **Record 2020-154**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak on 4 November 2020 in Belvidere, Boone County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-155**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak on 1 November 2020 in Tiskilwa, Bureau County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-156**

This was the first circulation of a record of up to 25 Evening Grosbeaks during 31 October to 1 November 2020 in St. Joseph, Champaign County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-157**

This was the first circulation of a record of seven to 11 Evening Grosbeaks during 1-2 November 2020 in Mattoon, Coles County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-158**

This was the first circulation of a record of three Evening Grosbeaks on 31 October 2020 at Gillson Park, Wilmette, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-159**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak on 4 November 2020 at

Montrose Point in Chicago's Lincoln Park, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-160**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak on 1 November 2020 in West Chicago, DuPage County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(1).

- **Record 2020-161**

This was the first circulation of a record of six Evening Grosbeaks on 1 November 2020 in Downers Grove, DuPage County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-162**

This was the first circulation of a record of seven Evening Grosbeaks during 2-3 November 2020 in Kaneville, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-163**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak on 6 November 2020 at Elburn Forest Preserve, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-164**

This was the first circulation of a record of one to five Evening Grosbeaks during 31 October to 4 November 2020 at Grunwald Farms Family Forest Preserve, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-165**

This was the first circulation of a record of seven Evening Grosbeaks on 6 November 2020 at Ft. Sheridan Forest Preserve, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of five A-PE and two A-DE(1).

- **Record 2020-166**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak on 14 November 2020 at Hampshire Forest Preserve, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-167**

This was the first circulation of a record of five Evening Grosbeaks on 31 October 2020 at Peterson Preserve, southeast of Cisco, Piatt County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-168**

This was the first circulation of a record of up to 25 Evening Grosbeaks during 17 December 2020 to 13 February 2021 in Rudement, Saline County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2020-169**
