

Secretary's Report: Calendar Year 2023

Here is a summary of the work of the Illinois Ornithological Records Committee (IORC) during 2023. Please note that that summary may not be all inclusive. Individuals are encouraged to consult the minutes of IORC meetings as well.

- The 28th report of IORC is written but is not yet published in Meadowlark. This report covers records reviewed during the 2022 calendar year.
- At the 14 January 2023 Annual Meeting, Steve Huggins and Dan Williams were elected to a three-year term on IORC, with both elected as new members.
- Broad-tailed Hummingbird was added to the Illinois State List of Birds (and to the Review List) upon acceptance of record 2023-087. Crested Caracara was added to the Illinois State List of Birds (and to the Review List) upon acceptance of record 2023-004. European Goldfinch was added to the Illinois State List of Birds (but not to the Review List) upon acceptance of record 2021-043.
- Evening Grosbeak was removed from the Review List. Broad-tailed Hummingbird, Crested Caracara, and Western Flycatcher were added to the Review List
- In 2023, IORC made decisions on 106 circulated records. There were 100 1st circulations, five 2nd circulations, zero 3rd circulations, and one 4th circulation.
 - Of the 100 1st circulations of records, one was accepted on specimen evidence, 87 were accepted based on physical evidence, three were accepted based on the full collection of documentary evidence, five were rejected based on identification, and four were moved to a second circulation.
 - Of the five 2nd circulations of records, three were accepted on physical evidence, and two were rejected based on identification.
 - The one 4th circulation of a record was rejected based on identification.
- The IORC online database at <http://empty-sunset-8541.herokuapp.com/> has moved to <http://iorc.herokuapp.com>. The content remains unchanged since the last secretary's report. Information from the first 22 IORC reports has been entered into the database. Data from the 23rd report forward have not yet been entered (these decisions are available at <https://www.illinoisbirds.org/illinois-ornithological-records-committee/>). This site needs some work.
- The Official Illinois State List of Birds (published online at <http://www.illinoisbirds.org/the-birds-of-illinois/>) is up to date with the present AOS taxonomy (through 7th edition on the check-list and through the 64th supplement published in July 2023). Changes to the list include the renaming of Northern Goshawk as American Goshawk and the addition of Western Flycatcher to the list (given the lumping of Pacific-slope Flycatcher and Cordilleran Flycatcher as Western

Flycatcher, so that the one record of Pacific-slope/Cordilleran Flycatcher now becomes one of Western Flycatcher).

On and after the Annual Meeting on 14 January 2023, the results of concluded circulations were as follows.

From the circulation of 28 December 2022:

- **Record 2022-061**
This was the second circulation of a record of one White-faced Ibis on 16 October 2022 at McGinnis Slough, Cook County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of one A-DE(3) and six U-ID.
- **Record 2022-063**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak on 24 October 2022 in Geneva, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of six A-DE(1) and one U-ID.
- **Record 2022-064**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak on 26 October 2022 at Kress Creek Farms Park, DuPage County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one U-ID.
- **Record 2022-074**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Pine Grosbeak on 12 November 2022 in Winthrop Harbor, Lake County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of three A-DE(1) and four U-ID.
- **Record 2022-075**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Eurasian Wigeon during 11-17 November 2022 at Mirador subdivision points, Kane County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of five A-PE and two U-ID.
- **Record 2022-076**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Prairie Falcon on 18 November 2022 at Illinois Beach State Park, North Unit, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-077**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 14 November 2022 at Winthrop Harbor, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-078**
This was the first circulation of a record of a breeding record of Merlin during 9 April to 8 July 2022 in Belvidere, Boone County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-079**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Bewick's Wren on 4 June 2022 at Hennepin

Canal, lock 21, Bureau County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of four A-DE(1) and three U-ID.

- **Record 2022-080**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Cave Swallow on 19 November 2022 at Ft. Sheridan Forest Preserve, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-DE(1).

- **Record 2022-081**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Rufous Hummingbird during 30 October to 21 November 2022 in Sorento, Bond County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(1).

- **Record 2022-082**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Rufous Hummingbird during 22-27 October 2022 in Davis, Stephenson County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of five A-PE and two A-DE(1).

- **Record 2022-085**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Ovenbird on 18 December 2022 at Hidden Lake Forest Preserve, DuPage County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of two A-PE and five A-DE(1).

- **Record 2022-086**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Prairie Falcon during 25 October 2022 to 19 February 2023 (and possibly later) southeast of Arcola in Coles County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2022-087**

This was the first circulation of a record of Prairie Falcon on 14 December 2022 at Horseshoe Lake State Park, Madison County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2022-088**

This was the first circulation of a record of Prairie Falcon on 15 December 2022 in Walnut, Bureau County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of one A-DE(1) and six U-ID.

From the circulation of 5 February 2023:

- **Record 2019-085**

This was the fourth circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 11 May 2019 at Horseshoe Lake State Park, Madison County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of five A-DE(1) and two U-ID.

From the circulation of 22 March 2023:

- **Record 2010-033**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Mountain Plover on 24 and 28 April 2010 east of Arcola, Douglas County. The result was to accept the record based on identification, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2022-075**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Eurasian Wigeon during 11-17 November 2022 at Mirador subdivision points, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on identification, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one U-ID.
- **Record 2022-079**
This was the second circulation of a record of one Bewick's Wren on 4 June 2022 at Hennepin Canal, lock 21, Bureau County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of two A-DE(1) and five U-ID.
- **Record 2022-089**
This was the first circulation of a record one Black-bellied Whistling-Duck during 12-17 December 2022 at Miller Park, Bloomington, McLean County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-001**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Evening Grosbeak during 6-19 January 2023 in Rockford, Winnebago County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-002**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Bohemian Waxwing during 7-8 January 2023 at Lake Le-Aqua-Na State Park in Stephenson County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-003**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Great-tailed Grackle during 15 January to 8 April 2023 (and possibly later) in Monee, Will County and in Richton Park, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-004**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Crested Caracara during 4-10 February 2023 in Emiquon National Wildlife Refuge and areas west of there, Fulton County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-005**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Ross's Gull during 11-15 March 2023 along the Lake Michigan lakefront in southeast Chicago, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-006**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Say's Phoebe during 11-19 March 2023 at Muirhead Springs Forest Preserve, Kane County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

From the circulation of 21 May 2023:

- **Record 2021-125**
This was the first circulation of a record of one MacGillivray's Warbler on 2 September 2021 at Forbes State Park, Marion County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of one A-PE, one A-DE(1), and five U-ID.
- **Record 2023-007**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Eastern Wood-Pewee on 10 January 2023 in Brownstown, Fayette County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of seven U-ID.
- **Record 2023-008**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 12 April 2023 in the Kaskaskia River valley about six to eight miles south-southwest of Vandalia, Fayette County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-009**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Ruff during 14-29 April 2023 at Porter Road west of the Boone-McHenry county line, Boone County and near the intersection of Union Road and IL-47, McHenry County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-010**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 23 April 2023 at Banner Marsh, Peoria County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of four A-DE(1) and three U-ID.
- **Record 2023-011**
This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Dove during 18-21 April 2023 in Bloomington, McLean County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-012**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Warbler on 27 April 2023 at Big Marsh, Chicago, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-013**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Gyrfalcon on 9 May 2023 at Waukegan Beach, Lake County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of four A-PE, one A-DE(1), and two U-ID.
- **Record 2023-014**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Kirtland's Warbler on 7 May 2023 at the Chicago Botanic Garden, Glencoe, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-015**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 3 May 2023 at Mermet Lake, Massac

County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-017**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Great-tailed Grackle on 12 May 2023 in Hartford, Madison County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of one A-DE(1) and six U-ID.

- **Record 2023-018**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Snowy Plover on 16 May 2023 at Montrose Point in Chicago's Lincoln Park, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

From the circulation of 5 July 2023:

- **Record 2021-126**

This was the first circulation of a record of one or two Swainson's Warblers during 30 April to 31 May 2021 at Cypress Creek National Wildlife Refuge (northwest of Hickory Bottoms access), Union County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2022-090**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Swainson's Warblers during 28-30 April 2022 at Cypress Creek National Wildlife Refuge (northwest of Hickory Bottoms access), Union County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-010**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 23 April 2023 at Banner Marsh, Peoria County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of three A-DE(1) and four U-ID.

- **Record 2023-013**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Gyrfalcon on 9 May 2023 at Waukegan Beach, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of four A-PE, two A-DE(1), and one U-ID.

- **Record 2023-016**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Ruff on 3 May 2023 at Carlyle Lake, Bond County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(2).

- **Record 2023-019**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Mottled Duck during 22 May to 13 June 2023 at Lake Springfield, Sangamon County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-020**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Gull-billed Tern on 1 June 2023 at Montrose

Point in Chicago's Lincoln Park, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-021**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 2 June 2023 at Horseshoe Lake, Alexander County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-025**

This was the first circulation of a record of four Painted Buntings during 20 May to 3 August 2023 at East St. Louis, St. Clair County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(8).

From the circulation of 20 September 2023:

- **Record 2021-127**

This was the first circulation of a record of one American Redstart on 4 December 2021 in Waukegan, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-026**

This was the first circulation of a record of one to two Limpkins during 30 June to 9 July 2023 at Heron Pond, Johnson County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-027**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 13 July 2023 at Clinton Lake, Massac County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-028**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 16 July to 27 August 2023 at Mermet Lake, Massac County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-030**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Roseate Spoonbill on 25 July 2023 at Carlyle Lake, Fayette County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-031**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 24 July to 8 October 2023 [and possibly later] at Skokie Lagoons Forest Preserve and Chicago Botanic Garden, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-032**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 26 July 2023 at Section 8 Woods, Pulaski County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-033**
This was the first circulation of a record of two Limpkins during 27-29 July 2023 at Sanganois State Fish and Wildlife Area, Cass County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-034**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Roseate Spoonbill during 6 August to 25 September 2023 moving between Dixon Waterfowl Refuge, Putnam County; Chautauqua National Wildlife Refuge, Mason County; Lacy Ditch, Fulton County; and Spring Lake Fish and Wildlife Area, Tazewell County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-035**
This was the first circulation of a record of one to two Limpkins during 5-21 August 2023 at Nygren Wetlands, Winnebago County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-036**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Roseate Spoonbill on 9 August 2023 at Techny Basin, Cook County and Great Lake Naval Training Center, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-037**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 13 August 2023 at Lake Pana, Shelby County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-038**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 13 August 2023 at Carlyle Lake, Clinton County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-039**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Ruff on 15 August 2023 at Nygren Wetlands, Winnebago County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-040**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 20 May 2023 in Oswego, Kendall County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-042**
This was the first circulation of a record of one to two Limpkins during 16 August to 21 September 2023 at Chautauqua National Wildlife Refuge, Mason County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-043**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 27-28 August 2023 at Lake

Arispie, Bureau County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-044**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 28 August to 4 September 2023 along Sangamon Creek north of the town of White Heath, Piatt County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-045**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Long-tailed Jaeger during 30-31 August 2023 at Chautauqua National Wildlife Refuge, Mason County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-046**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 28-30 August 2023 along the Galena River, JoDaviess County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-047**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 30 August to 18 September 2023 at Horseshoe Lake, Alexander County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of six A-PE and one A-DE(1).

- **Record 2023-048**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Ruff during 4-11 September 2023 at Chautauqua National Wildlife Refuge, Mason County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-050**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White Ibis during 9-11 September 2023 at Lacy Ditch, Fulton County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-053**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 13-14 September 2023 at McHenry Dam, McHenry County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-054**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 17 September 2023 along the Kishwaukee River, Winnebago County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

From the circulation of 5 November 2023:

- **Record 1970-002**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Rock Wren on 2 November 1970 in Normal, McLean County. The result was to accept the record based on specimen evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-SP.

- **Record 2010-035**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Purple Gallinule on 9 May 2010 at the Minonk wastewater treatment plant, Woodford County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-056**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Cinnamon Teal on 29 August 2023 at Goose Lake Prairie State Natural Area, Grundy County. The result was to move the record to a 2nd circulation, with a vote tally of five A-PE and two U-ID.
- **Record 2023-057**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Roseate Spoonbill during 23 September to 11 October 2023 at Fox Creek State Fish and Wildlife Area, Richland and Wayne counties. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-059**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 25 September 2023 at Amboy Marsh, Lee County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-060**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 25 September to 10 November 2023 at Westlake Lake and Nature Area, Winnebago County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-061**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Purple Gallinule on 26 September 2023 at Old Green Valley Park, Moline, Rock Island County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-062**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Roseate Spoonbill during 19-23 September 2023 in Savanna, Carroll County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-063**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 24 September 2023 at Grass Lake, Chain O' Lakes State Park, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-064**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 28 September to 11 November 2023 at McGinnis Slough, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-065**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 28 September to 4 November 2023 at Sylvan Island, Rock Island County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.

- **Record 2023-066**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Cassin's Kingbird on 30 September 2023 in Montgomery, Kendall County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-067**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Rock Wren during 8-11 October 2023 at Kress Creek Farms Park, West Chicago, DuPage County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-068**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Purple Gallinule during 3-6 October 2023 at Banner Marsh, Peoria County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-069**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 30 September to 21 October 2023 at Kickapoo State Recreation Area, Vermilion County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-070**
This was the first circulation of a record of four Anhingas on 7 October 2023 in Carol Stream, DuPage County. The result was to reject the record based on identification, with a vote tally of seven U-ID.
- **Record 2023-071**
This was the first circulation of a record of 1500 Franklin's Gulls on 7 October 2023 at Hennepin Canal Park and Lock 32, Rock Island County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-DE(1).
- **Record 2023-072**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Great-tailed Grackle on 11 October 2023 north of Monee, Will County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-073**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 12 October to 25 November 2023 at Lake Charleston, Coles County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-074**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 16 October to 11 December 2023 (and possibly later) at Mellody Farm Nature Preserve, Lake County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-077**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin on 26 October 2023 at Beacon Harbor Park, East Moline, Rock Island County. The result was to accept the record based on documentary evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-DE(1).

- **Record 2023-078**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Gray-crowned Rosy-Finch during 29-30 October 2023 at the Northwestern University Lakefill, Evanston, Cook County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-079**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Limpkin during 24 October to 27 November 2023 at Fullersburg Woods Forest Preserve, DuPage County. The result was to accept the record based on physical evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-PE.
- **Record 2023-080**
