

Secretary's Report: for meeting of 18 February 2018

Here is a summary of the work of the Illinois Ornithological Records Committee (IORC) during 2017.

- The 21st report of IORC was submitted for publication in *Meadowlark*, but it has not yet been published. The 21st report covers records concluded during 2015.
- IORC circulated 106 records.
 - Of the 89 first circulations of records, 58 were accepted based on physical evidence, nine were accepted based on written documentation, 10 were rejected based on identification, and 12 were moved to a second circulation.
 - Of the 12 second circulations of records, two were accepted based on physical evidence, three were rejected based on identification, one was rejected based on origin, and six were moved to a third circulation.
 - All four of the third circulations of records were moved to a fourth circulation.
 - One breeding record was considered; it was rejected in its first circulation.
- The first through nineteenth reports of IORC are available on the IOS web site. Though the 20th report was published during 2016, it has not yet been made available on the IOS web site. (It appears in vol. 24, which is not yet accessible online.)
- The status of the IORC online database at <http://empty-sunset-8541.herokuapp.com/> remains unchanged since the last secretary's report. Information from the first 18 IORC reports has been entered into the database. Data entry from reports 1 through 17 have double-checked with most errors corrected, data from the 18th report has been checked but errors have not been corrected, and data from the 19th, 20th, and 21st reports have not yet been entered.
- The Official Illinois State List of Birds (published online at <http://www.illinoisbirds.org/the-birds-of-illinois/>) is up to date with the present AOU taxonomy (through 7th edition on the check-list and through the 58th supplement). Status of species remains to be updated.

Regarding records 2016-074 and 2016-078, both involving California Gulls in Rock Island County, a question arose whether these records involved the same bird. Comments were solicited from the observer Steve Freed about why he thought these were different. These comments were circulated on 3 April 2017 to the seven IORC members and alternate member (J. Engel, R. Fisher, M. Fraker, K. McMullen, D. Stotz, P. Sweet, G. Williamson) who were present at the 12 February 2017 meeting of IORC at which this matter was first discussed. Those seven individuals were asked to vote on whether to merge the records. The resulting vote was one in favor of merging and six opposed.

On and after the meeting of 12 February 2017, the results of concluded circulations are as follows.

From the meeting of 12 February 2017:

- **Record 2009-030**

This was the first circulation of the resubmission of a record originally accepted as Green Violetear but resubmitted as Mexican Violetear after the taxonomic change by the A.O.S. of Green Violetear into Mexican Violetear and Lesser Violetear. The result was acceptance of the record as Mexican Violetear based on one photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

From the circulation of 4 December 2016:

One remaining record from this circulation was finalized on 17 April 2017.

- **Record 2016-076**

This was the first circulation of a record of breeding by Wilson's Snipe during June 2016 in Cook County. The result was rejection of the record with a vote tally of four U and three A.

From the circulation of 6 March 2017:

- **Record 1994-T-001 (temporary record number)**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Cassin's Vireo on 5 May 1994 at Jackson Park, Chicago, Cook County. The result was to move the record to a second circulation, with a vote tally of four A-S(1) and three U-I.

- **Record 2010-030**

This was the first circulation of a record of seven Anhingas on 13 October 2010 at Evergreen Lake in McLean County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of six U-I and one A-S(1).

- **Record 2016-063**

This was the second circulation of a record of two Swallow-tailed Kites on 20 August 2016 in New Douglas, Madison County. The result was to move the record to a third circulation, with a vote tally of four A-S(1) and three U-I.

- **Record 2016-073**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Brown-headed Nuthatch on 9 September 2016 at the Chicago Botanic Garden, Glencoe, Cook County. The result was to move the record to a third circulation, with a vote tally of four A-E(photo) and three U-I.

- **Record 2016-077**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Anhinga on 13 October 2016 at Greene Valley Forest Preserve, DuPage County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of four U-I, one A-S, and two A-S(1).

- **Record 2016-081**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Gyrfalcon on 6 November 2016 at Greene Valley Forest Preserve, DuPage County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of six U-I and one A-S.

- **Record 2016-086**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire on 15 November 2016 in Stockton, Jo Daviess County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).
- **Record 2016-087**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Mottled Duck on 25 November 2016 at Chautauqua National Wildlife Refuge in Mason County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of six A-E(photo) and one U-I.
- **Record 2016-088**
This was the first circulation of a record of two Mountain Bluebirds during 9 November 2016 through 17 February 2017 south of Savanna, Carroll County. The result was acceptance of the record as pertaining to one individual based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).
- **Record 2016-089**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire during 15 November 2016 through 2 January 2017 at Rock Cut State Park in Winnebago County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).
- **Record 2016-090**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Mottled Duck on 25 November 2016 at Big Lake, Brown County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of six U-I and one A-S(1).
- **Record 2016-091**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire during 3-5 December 2016 at Sand Ridge State Forest, Mason County. The result was to move the record to a second circulation, with a vote tally of four A-E(audio) and three U-I.
- **Record 2016-092**
This was the first circulation of a record one Cave Swallow on 28 October 2016 at Lake Springfield, Sangamon County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of four U-I and three A-S(1).
- **Record 2016-093**
This was the first circulation of a record of one California Gull during 30 November 2016 through 15 February 2017 on the Illinois River at Peoria, Peoria County and Tazewell County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).
- **Record 2016-094**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Vermilion Flycatcher on 6 November 2016 at Goose Lake Prairie State Park, Grundy County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).
- **Record 2016-095**
This was the first circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire on 5 November 2016 at Sag

Quarries, Lemont, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2016-096**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Say's Phoebe on 9 November 2016 outside of Savanna, Carroll County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2016-097**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Ruff on 16 July 2016 at the El Paso Sewage Treatment Plant, Woodford County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2016-099**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Barn Owl on 25 December 2016 at Burnham Park, Chicago, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on written documentation, with a vote tally of six A-S(1) and one A-S.

- **Record 2017-001**

This was the first circulation of a record of one California Gull during 4-14 February 2017 along the Calumet River in Chicago, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-002**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Bohemian Waxwing on 1 January 2017 at Shaw Woods, Lake Forest Openlands, Lake County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-003**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant on 26 February 2017 at Emiquon Preserve, Mason County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-004**

This was the first circulation of a record of one California Gull during 23-25 February 2017 at Channel Lake, Lake County. The result was acceptance of the record based on written documentation, with a vote tally of one A-E(photo), five A-S(1), and one A-S.

From the circulation of 26 June 2017:

- **Record 2012-039**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Red-naped Sapsucker during 5 to 6 April 2012 at Wadsworth Wetlands Forest Preserve, Lake County. This is a potential first state record. The result was to move the record to a second circulation, with a vote tally of five A-E(photo) and two U-I.

- **Record 2016-032**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Whooping Crane observed on 30 April 2016 in

Cook County. The result was rejection of the record based on origin, with a vote tally of five U-O, one U-I, and one A-S(1).

- **Record 2016-075**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Ruff on 20 September 2016 at Techny Basin, Glenview, Cook County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of five U-I, one A-E(video), and one A-E(photo).

From the circulation of 1 July 2017:

- **Record 1994-T-001 (temporary file number)**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Cassin's Vireo on 5 May 1994 at Jackson Park, Chicago, Cook County. The result was to move the record to a third circulation, with a vote tally of one A-S(2), four A-S(1), and two U-I.

- **Record 2013-080**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Say's Phoebe on 5 October 2013 at Moraine View State Park in McLean County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2016-063**

This was the third circulation of a record of two Swallow-tailed Kites on 20 August 2016 in New Douglas, Madison County. The result was to move the record to a fourth circulation (after discussion at a meeting of IORC), with a vote tally of five A-S(1) and two U-I.

- **Record 2016-073**

This was the third circulation of a record of one Brown-headed Nuthatch on 9 September 2016 at the Chicago Botanic Garden, Glencoe, Cook County. The result was to move the record to a fourth circulation (after discussion at a meeting of IORC), with a vote tally of four A-E(photo), one A-S, and two U-I.

- **Record 2016-091**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Townsend's Solitaire during 3-5 December 2016 at Sand Ridge State Forest in Mason County. The result was acceptance of the record based on audio evidence, with a vote tally of six A-E(audio) and one U-I.

- **Record 2017-005**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Semipalmated Plover on 7 March 2017 in Northbrook, Cook County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of four U-I and three A-S(1).

- **Record 2017-006**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Golden-crowned Sparrow during 21 March to 4 April 2017 at Letcher Basin in Woodford County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-007**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Dove on 18 March 2017 in Quincy,

Adams County. The result was acceptance of the record based on written documentation by one observer, with a vote tally of two A-E(photo) and five A-S(1).

- **Record 2017-008**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Black-headed Gull on 23 March 2017 on Lake Springfield, Sangamon County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of five A-E(photo) and two A-S(1).

- **Record 2017-009**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant on 28 March 2017 in Pontiac, Livingston County. The result was to move the record to a second circulation, with a vote tally of five A-E(photo) and two U-I.

- **Record 2017-010**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Swallow-tailed Kite on 7 April 2017 east of Metropolis, Massac County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-011**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Pine Grosbeak on 13 April 2017 in Rockton, Winnebago County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-012**

This was the first circulation of a record of three Black-bellied Whistling-Ducks on 9 May 2017 at Watershed Nature Center, Edwardsville, Madison County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-013**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Anhinga on 23 May 2017 in Jackson County. The result was to move the record to a second circulation, with a vote tally of five A-S(1) and two U-I.

- **Record 2017-014**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Dove on 4 June 2017 in River Grove, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-015**

This was the first circulation of a record of two Neotropic Cormorants during 4 June to 26 July 2017 at Almond Marsh Forest Preserve, Lake County (with two birds present for a portion of that period). The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-016**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant during 4 to 9 June 2017 at Nygren Wetland Preserve, Winnebago County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-017**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Western Tanager on 4 June 2017 at Illinois Beach

State Park, Lake County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-018**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Anhinga on 18 June 2017 at Oakwood Bottoms, Jackson County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-019**

This was the first circulation of a record of two Painted Buntings during 20 May to 31 July 2017 in East St. Louis, St. Clair County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-020**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Black Rail during 20 to 28 June 2017 at Montrose Point in Chicago's Lincoln Park, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on audio evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-021**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Tricolored Heron during 20-22 June 2017 at Illinois Beach State Park, Lake County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-022**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Dove on 19 June 2017 in River Forest, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-023**

This was the first circulation of a record of three Black-bellied Whistling-Ducks on 23 June 2017 in northwest Alexander County. The result was acceptance of the record based on written documentation by one observer, with a vote tally of six A-S(1) and one U-I.

From the circulation of 17 September 2017:

- **Record 1994-T-001 (temporary file number)**

This was the third circulation of a record of one Cassin's Vireo on 5 May 1994 at Jackson Park, Chicago, Cook County. The result was to move the record to a fourth circulation, with a vote tally of one A-S(2), four A-S(1), and two U-I.

- **Record 2010-031**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Black Rail on 10 May 2010 at Worship Trail, Cook County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of seven U-I.

- **Record 2012-039**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Red-naped Sapsucker during 5 to 6 April 2012 at Wadsworth Wetlands Forest Preserve, Lake County. This is a potential first state record. The

result was to move the record to a third circulation, with a vote tally of five A-E(photo) and two U-I.

- **Record 2016-100**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Dove on 17 May 2016 in Chicago, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2016-101**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Little Gull during 20-21 April 2016 at Lake Springfield, Sangamon County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A9-2-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-009**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant on 28 March 2017 in Pontiac, Livingston County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of six A-E(photo) and one U-I.

- **Record 2017-013**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Anhinga on 23 May 2017 in Jackson County. The result was to move the record to a third circulation, with a vote tally of four A-S(1) and three U-I.

- **Record 2017-024**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Wood Stork during 6-20 July 2017 at Rend Lake, Jefferson County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-025**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White Ibis during 9-20 July 2017 in Grand Tower Township, Jackson County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-026**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Dove during 6 July to 26 August 2017 in Kaneville, Kane County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-027**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Royal Tern on 8 July 2017 at Harborside Marina, Channahon Township, Will County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of four U-I and three A-S(1).

- **Record 2017-028**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Black-bellied Whistling-Duck on 22 July 2017 on Army Depot Road, Carroll County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-029**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Great Blue Heron (white form) on 12 July 2017 in

Savoy, Champaign County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of seven U-I.

- **Record 2017-030**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Swallow-tailed Kite on 27 July 2017 in Simpson, Pope County. The result was to move the record to a second circulation, with a vote tally of four A-S(1) and three U-I.

- **Record 2017-031**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant on 4 August 2017 at Lake Shelbyville, Moultrie County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-032**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Wood Stork on 5 August 2017 at the Sexton Creek wetlands, Alexander County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-033**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Black-bellied Whistling-Duck on 7 August 2017 at the Zuma Creek flats, Rock Island County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-034**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Say's Phoebe on 7 August 2017 at the Cape Bend wetlands, Alexander County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of four U-I and three A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-035**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Ruff during 20-21 August 2017 at Emiquon National Wildlife Refuge, Fulton County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

From the circulation of 2 December 2017:

- **Record 1994-037**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Ash-throated Flycatcher on 4 September 1994 at Jackson Park, Chicago, Cook County. The result was to move the record to a second circulation, with a vote tally of five A-S(1) and two U-I.

- **Record 2012-039**

This was the third circulation of a record of one Red-naped Sapsucker during 5 to 6 April 2012 at Wadsworth Wetlands Forest Preserve, Lake County. This is a potential first state record. The result was to move the record to a fourth circulation (after a discussion at a meeting of IORC), with a vote tally of five A-E(photo) and two U-I.

- **Record 2015-069**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Nashville Warbler (ridgwayi) on 20 October 2015

at the Jarvis Migratory Bird Sanctuary in Chicago's Lincoln Park, Cook County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of six U-I and one A-E(video).

- **Record 2016-102**

This was the first circulation of a record of two Prairie Falcons during 28 October 2016 to 29 January 2017 southwest of Arcola in Coles and Douglas Counties. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2016-103**

This was the first circulation of a record of two Prairie Falcons during 12 November 2016 to 9 January 2017 in the Mt. Erie bottoms, Wayne County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of six A-E(photo) and one A-S(1).

- **Record 2016-104**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Prairie Falcon on 28 December 2016 at Prairie Ridge State Natural Area, Jasper County. The result was acceptance of the record based on written documentation, with a vote tally of one A-E(photo) and six A-S(1).

- **Record 2017-030**

This was the second circulation of a record of one Swallow-tailed Kite on 27 July 2017 in Simpson, Pope County. The result was to move the record to a third circulation, with a vote tally of five A-S(1) and two U-I.

- **Record 2017-036**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger on 31 August 2017 at Montrose Point, Lincoln Park, Chicago, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-037**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Broad-billed Hummingbird during 11-13 September 2017 in Sherman, Sangamon County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-038**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant during 9-18 July 2017 in North Aurora, Kane County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-039**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White-winged Dove on 17 April 2017 in Le Roy, McLean County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-040**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Mountain Bluebird during 7-12 April 2017 at Fermilab, DuPage County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-041**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Parasitic Jaeger during 15-17 September 2017 at

Lake Shelbyville, Moultrie County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-042**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant during 1-24 July 2017 in Roselle, DuPage County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-043**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Tricolored Heron on 8 July 2017 at Pine Dunes Forest Preserve, Lake County. The result was to move the record to a second circulation, with a vote tally of four A-S(1) and three U-I.

- **Record 2017-044**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant during 24 April to 6 June 2017 at Lake Springfield, Sangamon County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-045**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Say's Phoebe on 19 September 2017 at Lake Springfield, Sangamon County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-046**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant on 14 July 2017 at Grand Tower, Jackson County. The result was acceptance of the record based on written documentation, with a vote tally of one A-E(photo), five A-S(1), and one U-I.

- **Record 2017-047**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant on 15 September 2017 at Chicago's Rainbow Beach, Cook County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of seven A-E(photo).

- **Record 2017-048**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Neotropic Cormorant on 29 September 2017 in Carpentersville, Kane County. The result was rejection of the record based on identification, with a vote tally of four U-I and three A-S(1).

- **Record 2017-049**

This was the first circulation of a record of one Pacific Loon during 4-5 November 2017 at the Emiquon Preserve, Fulton County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of four A-E(photo), two A-S(2), and one U-I.

- **Record 2017-050**

This was the first circulation of a record of one to six White-faced Ibis during 28 September to 29 October 2017 at Glacial Park, McHenry County. The result was acceptance of the record based on photographic evidence, with a vote tally of four A-E(photo), one A-S(2), one A-S(1), and one U-I.

- **Record 2017-051**

This was the first circulation of a record of one White-faced Ibis during 21-22 October 2017 at
