It would help to have your original description (and earlier IORC submission if you have it?) in support of this write-up that comes 18 years after the fact.

18 years? or 28 years?

fwiw, I always was under the impression that IORC was perfectly aware of the record, but just wasn't moving on it. the last time Doug mentioned it was in April 2017, when he told me that

"The Plumbeous Vireo is still in limbo, but Josh confirmed the existence of the documentation while searching for Paul's material [re Paul Clyne's Jackson Park Cassin's Vireo]. My guess is that Geoff will bring the Plumbeous Vireo to the fore sometime in the next few months".

so the original documentation reportedly still sits somewhere in IORC files, but perhaps would have stayed there forever if I hadn't submitted this to eBird. (news to you, perhaps, that last year you were on the cusp of bringing this to the fore?)
