I submitted a documentation of this record to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources and published details in Meadowlark 3.4:141-142, q.v. In brief, a very drab vireo in the "Solitary Vireo" complex, with an olive-green head (but with a dull gray wash, strongest on forehead and absent on nape), dull white throat and dull yellow wash to sides of upper breast. Photograph #3 (p. 375) in Farrand's 1988 Western Birds: An Audubon Handbook provides a very good match to the Jackson Park bird, although our bird may have been even less gray on the head than the photo bird. Significantly, this bird was singing persistently over a three-day period, 3-5 May, in the Japanese Garden at the northeast corner of Wooded Island on the first two dates, and between the Darrow Bridge and north bridge of Wooded Island on the last date. The song was likened by

all observers to that of Yellow-throated Vireo; compared to typical songs of Blue-headed Vireo, the song was lower in pitch, burry rather than sweet, with much longer pauses between phrases. No variations in song pattern were noted. At the time of occurrence, cassinii was classified as a subspecies of "Solitary Vireo" (V. solitarius), along with Plumbeous Vireo (form plumbeus). Unlike plumbeus, however, cassinii had received essentially no attention in field guide treatments of this complex, and most of the observers had no knowledge of its existence, much less characteristics, until the morning of the last date observation, when it was seen singing by Thomas S. Schulenberg (who was the first to propose cassinii as a candidate), Robert D. Hughes, and me. Subsequent attempts later that morning and the following day to record and / or elicit response from playbacks of vireo songs were in vain. As far as I am aware, none of the other six or more observers of this bird submitted documentation.
