Hello Geoffrey, Doug Stotz asked me to send you some photos of the Bohemian Waxwing taken today and in November. His e-mail to me is enclosed. "Dear Nolan, Your dazzling photos of today's Bohemian Waxwing encouraged me to take a look at your earlier photos. You are absolutely correct that this is a different bird. The white versus yellow in the wing, the different shape of the markings, the lack of the red tips on the November birds, and the little short crest of the November bird make that clear. I'd like to ask that you send copies of these photos to Geoff Williamson for IORC to review. Your photos will make clear that there were unquestionably multiple birds present. I especially like the photo of the bird with its wing open as it takes off. I hadn't really fully understood that the small horizontal white bar on the wing was the tips of the secondaries.
