The habitat description of flooded woodland (able to be kayaked in) is not consistent with preferred breeding habitat (moist, but not flooded, woodlands; and canebreaks), but perhaps this individual was still moving around more widely in early-to-mid-May. With reservation, I am voting to accept this record.
